




# SITE PLAN



# LAS HUELGAS REALES MONASTERY

The complex, declared a Historic-Artistic Monument, consists of several parts: the church, the monastery and the cloistered area.

Trappist abbey located in Castrillo del Val, 10 km from the center of Burgos.





## **BURGOS CATHEDRAL**

One of the best examples of Gothic art in Europe. Its construction began in 1221, although in later centuries it underwent some modifications.






## **HUMAN EVOUTION MUSEUM**

Located on the Paseo de la Sierra de Atapuerca, next to the Arlanzón river, it is one of the main recreational and leisure areas.








## WALLS AND CASTLE OF BURGOS

Erected by Count Diego Rodríguez Porcelos in the year 884, at the time of the Reconquest.






# ARCH OF SANTA MARÍA

The Arch of Santa Maria is one of the most emblematic monuments of Burgos that constituted in the Middle Ages one of the twelve ancient gates of access to the city.





## **BURGOS MUSEUM**

Located inside the palaces known as the Houses of Íñigo Ángulo, Miranda and Melgosa. It has a section of Prehistory and Archaeology and another of Fine Arts.





# ESPOLÓN PROMENADE

The most central and popular tree-lined and landscaped promenade in Burgos. It was created at the end of the XVIII century and was shaped during the XIX century.
